

West Sussex Joint Minerals Local Plan – Soft Sand Review

The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

Statement of Submission and Availability of Submitted Documentation

West Sussex County Council and the South Downs National Park Authority have prepared a Soft Sand Review of the West Sussex Joint Minerals Local Plan that has now been submitted to the Secretary of State for independent examination.

The Soft Sand Review sets out modifications to the West Sussex Joint Minerals Local Plan in relation to the supply of soft sand, and includes site allocations. The area covered is the administrative areas of West Sussex County Council, including the part of the South Downs National Park Authority that lies within West Sussex.
