Every year, more than **430 animals** come through the doors of **Mount Noddy Animal Centre**. Many arrive frightened, neglected, injured or abandoned, needing not only veterinary treatment but also time, patience and kindness before they can begin a new life with a loving family.

Alongside our rescue work, we support vulnerable pet owners throughout the local community. Through our outreach programme we provide emergency pet food, subsidised neutering, welfare advice and access to veterinary care, helping people through difficult times while preventing unnecessary animal suffering and abandonment.

As an independent charity, we receive **no government funding** for this work. Every meal, every veterinary treatment and every safe night in our kennels and cattery is made possible through the generosity of local people, businesses and organisations.

We would be incredibly grateful if your council offers donations/ grants, that we might be considered be able to apply for a grant to support our charitable work?

A contribution of any size would help local animals, support responsible pet ownership, reduce unwanted litters through preventative work, and make a lasting difference to families across your community.
